NEW YORK TRIP 2017

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29th**

Each fall semester, the Visual Arts Program offers an extended 5-day field trip to New York City to visit major art museums and galleries. Accompanied by at least two Visual Arts faculty members, students travel by chartered bus to and from Manhattan and stay in a three-star hotel conveniently located in the heart of Times Square. The New York trip provides an invaluable opportunity for educational immersion in one of the world's leading centers of both traditional and contemporary art.

PLEASE NOTE: While all students are strongly encouraged to participate in the New York trip in either year one or two of the Program, student participation is optional and not a mandatory component of the Visual Arts Program.

ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST: \$690 CAN

The above is an estimated *maximum* cost. The final cost of the trip will be determined in early September. Overall cost is subject to change depending on total number of student participants and currency and foreign exchange rates for the Canadian dollar.

Estimated cost includes:

- Bus travel to and from NYC
- Bus or public transportation to scheduled destinations within NYC
- 4 nights lodging in mid-town Manhattan
- Entrance fees for all scheduled destinations

VALID PASSPORT AND TRAVEL INSURANCE REQUIRED

A valid passport and travel insurance are required in order to participate. If you have a passport issued from a country other than Canada, please verify whether or not you are required to have an additional travel VISA for entry into the United States.

SCHEDULED DESTINATIONS

STORM KING ART CENTER

Widely celebrated as one of the world's leading sculpture parks, Storm King Art Center has welcomed visitors from across the globe for fifty years. It is located only one hour north of New York City, in the lower Hudson Valley, where its pristine 500-acre landscape of fields, hills, and woodlands provides the setting for a collection of more than 100 carefully sited sculptures created by some of the most acclaimed artists of our time.

METROPOLITAN MUSEUM OF ART

The Metropolitan Museum of Art, located in New York City, is the largest art museum in the United States and among the most visited art museums in the world.

MET BREUER MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART

The Met Breuer is the Metropolitan Museum of Art's newly opened space devoted to modern and contemporary art.

CHELSEA GALLERY AND LOWER EAST SIDE GALLERY DISTRICTS

Chelsea District and the Lower East Side represent two of Manhattan's premier contemporary art districts, home to numerous public and commercial art galleries.

MUSEUM OF MODERN ART (MOMA)

Founded in 1929 as an educational institution, the Museum of Modern Art is dedicated to being the foremost museum of modern art in the world. The collection includes an ever-expanding range of visual expression, including painting, sculpture, printmaking, drawing, photography, architecture, design, film, and media and performance art.

GUGENHEIM MUSEUM OF ART

An internationally renowned art museum and one of the most significant architectural icons of the 20th century, the Guggenheim Museum is at once a vital cultural center, an educational institution, and the heart of an international network of museums.
