Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue, home to John Abbott College and located in the English speaking section of Montreal, is nestled between two beautiful lakes on the western tip of the island (yes, Montreal is an island city!). It is a 50-minute public transit ride from the downtown core.

Academic Program

While at John Abbott College, you will participate in 6 or 7 courses per semester (there are 2 semesters in 1 school year). These courses match the Swiss curriculum. All courses are offered in English (except Italian and German).

Physical education courses (fitness, team sports, canoeing, kayaking, etc.) are included in your curriculum. They are a great way to improve your English language skills.

Tutoring is available, free of charge, in all academic areas.

During the month of June, you will participate in an innovative program called **Leadership and Outdoor Education**.

During this course, you will learn valuable leadership skills while participating in rock climbing, mountaineering, and canoeing activities, and a two night camping trip in the Canadian wilderness.

Homestay

John Abbott College operates our own homestay program. Living with our multicultural families will give you the chance to experience a "real Canadian life". Your host family will treat you like a member of their own family.

All of our host families undergo a police verification check and in-home interviews from our homestay coordinator. Your homestay experience will include a furnished bedroom and three meals a day plus snacks.

Extra-Curricular Activities

The Student Activities department at John Abbott College plays an important role in strengthening your English communication skills. Most importantly, this is where you will make many **Canadian friends**.

You will be able to participate in things like:

 Intramural sports such as soccer, basketball, badminton, volleyball and more.

- Student clubs in the following areas: anime, educational activism, the environment, model United Nations, breakdancing, kayaking, rock climbing, and many more!
