ARTS AND SCIENCES 700.A0

This program is for students with wide-ranging curiosity and a passion for disciplines in both arts and sciences. In this program, students take four math courses and five or six science courses, as well as art, art history, psychology, history, sociology, and political economy. The program qualifies them for admission to any Science or Social Science program at Québec universities, including medicine, dentistry, architecture, and law.

ARTS, LITERATURE & COMMUNICATION 500.A_

Graduates will be prepared to enter university in fields related to the arts, including communications, education, humanities, law, and liberal arts. Are you looking to develop your imagination and technical skills, as well as strong reading and writing skills? Consider one of the following profiles:

Languages: Students focus on modern languages while choosing courses from the other ALC disciplines to broaden their preparation in the arts.

Theatre: Students acquire concrete experience and knowledge of theatre arts while also taking other production courses.

Literature: Students can focus on literature and creative writing, while choosing courses from the other ALC disciplines to broaden their preparation in the arts.

Media: Students focus on the practical skills of different media (film, radio, TV, photography, animation, etc.).

Multidisciplinary: Students can enroll in a wide variety of courses chosen from the other options including creative writing, philosophy, religion, art history, and the various media arts.

All students take compulsory courses in economics, history, psychology and methodology.

Social Science: Designed for students who are interested in fields such as anthropology, business, classics, geography, mathematics, philosophy, political science, religion and sociology.

Social Science with Mathematics: Designed for students who enjoy math yet wish to select from a variety of social science subjects.

Social Science with Commerce: Designed for students interested in pursuing business studies at university.

Social Science with Psychology: Designed for students interested in pursuing psychology studies at university. Students can transfer into this profile upon successful completion of Quantitative Methods.
