

## FOR JAC BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION – MARKETING (410.D0) STUDENTS WHO ARE PLANNING TO APPLY TO BISHOP’S UNIVERSITY’S WILLIAMS SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

JAC students with strong academic backgrounds can save up to one year at university through this agreement. The agreement applies to 410.D0 students applying into the Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA) program at Bishop’s University.

Students will be granted exemptions from specific pre-requisite courses providing they meet the following criteria:

- completed the 410.D0 program;
- minimal R-score shown below<sup>1</sup>; and
- successful completion of the required mathematics courses<sup>2</sup>; and
- the delay between the completion of the college program and the entrance in the university program is less than five (5) years.

### Equivalencies Recognized by Bishop’s University

Students who meet the conditions identified above will receive the following advanced credits<sup>3</sup> according to their R-Score.

#### R-Score equal or above 28:

<sup>1</sup> Bishop’s University may admit students having a lower R-score, but cannot guarantee their admission.

<sup>2</sup> These courses can be completed at Bishop’s University during the first year. If applicable, they are added to the university program and can extend the length of the program.

<sup>3</sup> The credits are in addition of those already received for any students who have completed a DEC and entering in any 120-credit university program at Bishop’s University.

<sup>4</sup> Students need to complete two work placements of 8-12 weeks each of a Work-Study option to get these 3 credits.

**R-Score below 26:**

No advanced credits are awarded.
